Welcome to our quarterly newsletter! We are thrilled to share with you the latest developments in our mission to make a positive impact in our community.

First, we would like to express our gratitude to all of our supporters and volunteers who have continued to give to us. Your generosity and dedication have allowed us to keep our programs running smoothly and effectively.

This year we have seen 115 unique individuals for a total of 576 client visits! We have surpassed last year's visits (January - December 2023) in the number of pregnancy tests, material aid, and referrals. This month, we will surpass last year's visit numbers for ultrasound visits.

With this growth in services, we are moving to a larger facility. This move will be to accommodate the increased number of clients, need for additional staff/volunteer space, group meetings and a boutique for clients to shop.

Program Spotlight - Earn While You Learn

This educational and mentoring program is designed for parents or prospective parents to watch videos with a volunteer mentor on various topics such as parenting, pregnancy, birth, and life skills. Sessions occur in-person at our office or virtually. Participants earn points during these mentoring sessions which can be used in exchange for diapers, wipes, cribs, and many other baby necessities.

Each in-person Earn While You Learn session offers a spin on the wheel to earn extra points for larger items or a gift bag prize! Clients have the option for worksheets to complete at home to further reinforce the concepts learned.

The coolest part of this program - it's not just for women who are pregnant. Parents of young children are also welcome to participate, and we love it when dads want to learn and earn points as well!

Michelle joined the PCC team in late June. She has abundant experience in office management, coordination of services, and scheduling. She is the backbone of our office!


Michelle lives in Indian River with her husband, two daughters, dog Lilly and cat Sebastian.

Stories of impact: Mercades' Journey

After 11 years of trying for a second child, Mercades and her husband didn't think the moment would happen. When Mercades found out she was expecting, she was nervous about waiting so long for an appointment with her OB. Mercades had heard of the Pregnancy Care Center (PCC) from a friend, but didn't give it a second thought until she was discussing how anxious she was with the ladies at the WIC office. Mercades found herself making an appointment with our office.

"The ultrasound eased my anxious feelings about truly confirming my pregnancy. The moment I saw his little body on the screen, I cried happy tears and it was such an emotional moment. Just to have that precious picture of him knowing that he's truly there after all this time just fills my heart and soul with so much happiness and gratitude."



Once she received her pregnancy confirmation at the PCC, Mercades immediately knew she was going to participate in our programs.

"I am grateful for the earn while you learn program. From the donated maternity clothes to helping me with purchasing a pregnancy pillow. I have saved a majority of my points to earn my son's bedside bassinet and eventually his very own crib. I'll forever cherish the connections I've made with the women who volunteer there."

Mercades looks forward to the day when she is able to give back to the community as a volunteer with Pregnancy Care Center.

"I'm personally looking forward to volunteering one day when my son is bigger. Just so I can be that person to help someone else like me because I'm familiar enough with starting over from nothing but it will be easier with help."

Mercades' story is a testament to the power of the Pregnancy Care Center's staff and volunteers. Our main source of advertising services is through word of mouth and how lives can be changed for the better.

How to talk about the Pregnancy Care Center

As shown in Mercades story, talking about the PCC in the community is a wonderful way to spread awareness and why so many people reach out to us. Nearly half of new clients have learned about PCC by word of mouth, allowing women and men to see their sweet baby on an ultrasound! **Help us reach more people in need with these talking points about what we do.**

A safe place to navigate an unplanned pregnancy

A calm environment to talk with staff about their situation and gather medically accurate information about their options.

Free & Confidential Ultrasounds

An ultrasound is the essential next step after a positive pregnancy test. It confirms pregnancy, and due date.

Ongoing Support & Resources

Some feel alone and like abortion is their only option, the PCC provides tangible ongoing support for people facing pregnancy.

Our generous donors make is possible for us to provide all services completely free to our clients. We are funded by individuals, foundations and small private grants. **We do not accept any government funding.** This gives us the freedom to share about Christ with our clients.


